

Runners: The 5k course starts and ends at the Bellefonte Middle School and proceeds through the hilly area of Parkview Heights. The course is moderately challenging.

The 10K course—runs the 5K then reverses the 5K course—resulting in 6.2 miles of challenging hills.

Walkers: Indoor and outdoor routes are available.

Water stations are available along the route and an EMT will be present.

Incorporated in 2003, the Bellefonte FaithCentre provides the local community with:
